HSC Minimum Standards

Future information for Year 6 going into Year 7 for 2018.

The HSC minimum literacy standard is part of the Stronger HSC reforms announced in July 2016 by the Minister for Education. From 2020 students need to demonstrate a minimum standard to be eligible for the HSC. Students will have multiple opportunities to demonstrate they meet the standard between Year 9 and the time they complete their HSC. This year is the first opportunity for Year 9 students to meet the standard when they sit NAPLAN in May. Students can demonstrate they meet the minimum standard by achieving Band 8 or above in reading, writing and numeracy.
